President's Message



"Encouraging sustainable economic growth in the Great Lakes" February 10th, 2022, via Zoom



The Council brings together an equal number of Canadian and USA representatives from the provinces and states bordering the Great Lakes. The five lakes constitute the largest freshwater system in the world, and the area has a population of 100 million and total annual GDP of 6.0 trillion USD.

The presentation was conducted in a Q&A format with Lloyd Posno directing questions to Mark Fisher. Many topics were covered including climate change and contamination (global warming, water levels, oil pipelines, plastic waste); the relationship with our U.S. neighbour (their GDP mostly internal, ours mostly external; political and trade issues); and the challenges of staffing and funding the Council.

Mark provided the following link to an Economic Forum his group is hosting this June. Members can learn more about the Great Lakes Economic Forum at greatlakeseconomicforum.com. This would be worth attending.

The question period following the presentation was one of the busiest in recent memory and lasted about 20 minutes. A clear indication that our members found Mark Fisher's presentation interesting and informative.

April: Bill Robson took office as CEO of the C.D. Howe Institute in July 2006, after serving as the Institute's Senior Vice President since 2003 and Director of Research from 2000 to 2003. He has written more than 240 monographs, articles, chapters, and books on such subjects as government budgets, pensions, healthcare financing, inflation, and currency issues. His work has won awards from the Policy Research Secretariat, the Canadian Economics Association, and the Donner Canadian Foundation. He is a Senior Fellow at Massey College and holds an ICD.D designation from the Institute of Corporate Directors. He is a member of the Panel of Senior Advisors to the Auditor General of Ontario and the Ifo World Economic Survey expert group and a regular commentator on BNN/Bloomberg.
